

COURSE INFORMATION

RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and the United States Golf Association shall govern all play except as indicated in the Local Rules of Valley Golf & Country Club.

LOCAL RULES OF VALLEY GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

OBSTRUCTIONS:

- All service roads, whether or not artificially surfaced.
- All unmarked concrete open canals used for drainage.
- Concrete bank tops defining but not inside the boundaries of water hazards.
- Sprinklers, poles, electrical & control boxes, half-way houses, shelters, all other man-made structures.

DELINIATIONS:

- White Stakes and the perimeter walls denote "Out-of-Bounds" (OB).
- Yellow Stakes border Water Hazards.
- Red Stakes border Lateral Water Hazards.
- Blue Stakes indicate Ground Under Repair.

YARDAGE MARKERS:

- Fairway Markers and yardages are measured to the front of the green.
- Yardage from the tee boxes are measured to the middle of the green.

GOLF IS A GENTLEMAN'S SPORT!

As a courtesy to the following flights:

- Make sure divots are filled, pitch marks are repaired and bunkers are raked.
- Please play without undue delay.
- Limit your search for lost balls to 5 minutes.
- Allow faster groups to pass whenever practical.
- Upon reaching the green on a Par 3 hole, allow the following flight to hit their tee shots.

ALWAYS FOLLOW GOLF CART RULE OF THE DAY

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- All tractor and tire marks.
- All other areas properly marked by blue stakes or white paint.
- "Edging grooves" (the point at which the edge of the fringe and the fairway meet).
"If a ball lies on an edging groove around the putting green, the player may, without penalty, lift the ball, clean it and place it out of the groove in the nearest position to where it lay, whether on or off the putting green, which is not nearer the hole."
- Stones in bunkers may be removed. Should the ball move in the process, it must be replaced in its original lie without penalty.
- Anthills / garbage piles.
- All areas within the course are "through the green" unless otherwise marked.

REMINDERS TO ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS ON THE UPKEEP OF OUR GOLF COURSE:

Always remind your caddies of their responsibilities at the golf course, including removal of foreign weeds, at times when they are not servicing their players.

Keep our golf course clean. Please throw your trash on the bins and cigarette butts on the ashtrays provided all around the golf course.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

Any amateur player is allowed to obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only (no slope). Rule 14-3, GPS and range finders are allowed with no slope.

WEATHER WARNING SIREN:

- Stop play upon hearing a series of intermittent blasts.
- Resume play upon hearing one long blast.

LOCAL RULES OF VALLEY GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

OBSTRUCTIONS:

- All service roads, whether or not artificially surfaced.

DELINIATIONS:

- Fairway Markers and yardages are measured to the front of the green.

GOLF IS A GENTLEMAN'S SPORT!

As a courtesy to the following flights:

- Make sure divots are filled, pitch marks are repaired and bunkers are raked.
- Please play without undue delay.
- Limit your search for lost balls to 5 minutes.
- Allow faster groups to pass whenever practical.
- Upon reaching the green on a Par 3 hole, allow the following flight to hit their tee shots.

ALWAYS FOLLOW GOLF CART RULE OF THE DAY

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- All tractor and tire marks.
- All other areas properly marked by blue stakes or white paint.
- "Edging grooves" (the point at which the edge of the fringe and the fairway meet).
"If a ball lies on an edging groove around the putting green, the player may, without penalty, lift the ball, clean it and place it out of the groove in the nearest position to where it lay, whether on or off the putting green, which is not nearer the hole."
- Stones in bunkers may be removed. Should the ball move in the process, it must be replaced in its original lie without penalty.
- Anthills / garbage piles.
- All areas within the course are "through the green" unless otherwise marked.

REMINDERS TO ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS ON THE UPKEEP OF OUR GOLF COURSE:

Always remind your caddies of their responsibilities at the golf course, including removal of foreign weeds, at times when they are not servicing their players.

Keep our golf course clean. Please throw your trash on the bins and cigarette butts on the ashtrays provided all around the golf course.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE
